By scheduling this party, you agree to the following Health Policy, Code of Conduct, and Waiver for all members of your group:

Health Policy

To ensure the safety of our visitors and staff, Hands On Children's Museum requires that anyone entering the facility be free of the following symptoms that are related to the COVID-19 virus including fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea. By scheduling this party, you confirm that all members of your group are not currently experiencing these symptoms and that you will reschedule your visit should any symptoms present themselves before entry. Refunds will be provided as described in our cancellation policy.

Code of Conduct

We are committed to providing a healthy and safe environment at the Hands On Children's Museum and we need your help! We are asking our visitors to partner with us in our COVID-19 wellness efforts. When visiting, you are agreeing to follow our Code of Conduct for all members of your group. This includes wearing a face covering as mandated by the [WA Secretary of Health](#), maintaining proper social distancing (6-feet) from others not in your group, following directional signage, washing hands, and using hand sanitizer or wipes. We appreciate your support in helping us keep our visitors and staff healthy and safe.

Waiver

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is a very contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death.
